## **STIPULATIONS REGARDING STUDENT FEES**

### **GENERAL**

The Executive Management reserves the right to amend, without prior notice, all fees payable to International Training College-Lingua.

### **FINANCE REGULATIONS**

#### **TUITION FEES**

2.2 Tuition fees paid in instalments, shall be paid on or before the 1st of every month, irrespective of the date of enrolment/commencement of classes. A penalty of 10% per month will be charged on late payments.

2.3 Students in arrears of up to one (1) month's instalment will be suspended from classes until such fees owed have been paid in full.

2.4 Students in arrears will not be allowed to sit for any examination.

No transcripts and/or examination results shall be released to any student before clearing of all outstanding fees.

2.5 Fees are payable every month, whether a student receives an account or not. Failure to adhere to stipulated due dates may result in de-registration, withholding of results, refusal of access to accommodation, examinations and any other services.

2.6 It is the responsibility of each student to obtain financial statements and verify his/her account(s) regularly.

2.7 Outstanding balances of previous years should be settled in full before registration for the next year.

## **PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS**

3.1 Cash payments must be made only to the cashier and not to any other staff member.

3.2 A stamped College receipt will be issued upon payments being made.

3.3 Students who make payments at the cashier should verify their receipts and change before leaving the counter.

## **REFUND POLICY**

4.1 There will be No Refund on any payment made.

4.2 Students/parents/legal guardians are advised to confirm or liaise with the finance personnel to avoid any overpayment made.

4.3 “Inter-college transfers are accepted in accordance with the institution’s transfer regulations and program requirements.”

4.4 No Refund - January intake: Cancellation of course after 02nd March of each year

4.5 No Refund - June intake: Cancellation within three weeks after commencement of course

### **SPECIAL CONSIDERATION**

All Fees charged for the 2026 academic year (examinations included) settled before 28 February 2026 (January Intake) and 31 August 2026 (June Intake), will receive N\$1000.00 discount provided that they are self-funded students.

### **FAMILY REBATE**

6.1 When more than one (1) child from a family (from the same parent) enroll for full-time study at International Training College-Lingua, each child will receive a 10% discount on the tuition fees.

6.2 Applicants must provide a full birth certificate as proof that at least one parent is the same or documentary proof that they are legally adopted.

### **STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

#### **LOANS FROM BANKS**

Most banks offer loans at preferential interest rates. Further information can be obtained directly from the banks.

Students may apply for Loans/Bursaries from the Namibian Student Financial Assistance Fund (NSFAF), and any other Government Loan/Bursary provided that they meet the requirements.

7.2 An application for funding does not necessarily guarantee that a grant/loan has been granted. Students who are successful in their application for a grant or loan, should present proof of such assistance to the college. Kindly note that the letter of acknowledgement is not a guarantee for a loan to be awarded.

7.3 Students funded by NSFAF and other sponsors are required to pay full registration fees and the deposit upon registration and are required to continue with monthly instalment until such a time that the student receives a final award letter.

7.4 Unless payment has been received, no confirmation letters by sponsors during the examination period will be accepted for examination admission.

Written proof of sponsorship must be provided by students at registration.
